SECTION 8 - FIRST AID MEASURES

SPECIFIC MEASURES

SKIN: IMMEDIATELY FLUSH WITH WATER FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES. REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHING. IF IRRITATION PERSISTS OR IF CONTACT HAS BEEN PROLONGED, OBTAIN MEDICAL ATTENTION.

EYES: FLUSH WITH WATER FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES. CALL PHYSICIAN.

INHALATION: REMOVE VICTIM TO FRESH AIR. IF BREATHING STOPPED, BEGIN ARTIFICIAL RESPIRATION. CALL PHYSICIAN.

INGESTION: IF PATIENT IS FULLY CONSCIOUS, RINSE MOUTH WITH WATER AND DRINK 1 GLASS OF WATER. INDUCE VOMITING. DO NOT GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON. OBTAIN MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY.

GENERAL: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
